- 1 letter of recommendation

The Howard University Degree Completion Program (DCP) in Human Development (HD) is a four-year undergraduate program dedicated to individuals who have not earned college/university credit for at least one year. Our flexible, 100% online program is designed for working professionals, service members, and individuals at any stage of their personal and professional journey. The human development degree completion program will consist of structured curricula that provide a clear, well-defined pathway to the bachelor's degree.
